

TOWN OF McCANDLESS  
MINUTES – COUNCIL’S SERVICES COMMITTEE  
NOVEMBER 7, 2016 TOWN HALL

The meeting was called to order at 8:06 p.m. by Committee Chairman Walkauskas, with the following in attendance: Council Members Zachary, Aufman, Mertz, Powers, LeDonne and McKim. Others present: Town Attorney Ries, Town Manager Cordek, Assistant Town Manager Ebner, Fire Marshal Stack, Chief Di Santi, Public Works Superintendent Sabina, Zoning Officer/Land Use Administrator Betty, Marie Haller, Administrative Assistant and citizens as per the sign-in sheet.

FIRE MARSHAL’S REPORT

The Committee reviewed the Fire Marshal’s report for the month of September 2016. Fire Marshal Stack provided an overview of his report and remarked that September was a busy month with 74 calls, 540 year-to-date. The calls included a mix of vehicle and residential incidents along with a moderate number of false alarms. CCAC Nursing, Environmental Science training was conducted in September, with approximately 65 students.

REVIEW BUDGET PROGRAM 411

Fire Marshal Stack provided an overview of Program 411, Fire Protection and Prevention. The Committee discussed the history of the Apparatus Fund; it was clarified that this fund is a self-sustaining revolving fund which was established a long time ago for the purpose assisting the fire companies with the purchase and replacement of fire apparatus. Committee members also discussed the number of fire hydrants and false alarms. Fire Marshal Stack reported there are approximately 600 fire hydrants maintained in the Town. He noted false alarm fees continue to be assessed and monies from these fees are deposited into the Fire Apparatus Fund.

EVENTS SCHEDULED

The Services Annual Appreciation Banquet is scheduled on November 19. Fire Marshal Stack extended an invitation to Council.
