CHIEFS REPORT

Chief Anderson provided an overview of his January Activity Report and reported there was a burglary at residence currently under renovation and actor(s) stole numerous tools.

Councilman LeDonne asked Chief if officers reported any notable issues pertaining to the recent snowstorm. Chief commented there were no problems and Officers handled road conditions well. Councilman McKim discussed a recent incident on Rineman Road, suggested perhaps this was an incident related to aggressive driving. The Chief answered questions pertaining to the aggressive driving surveillance of the Wexford Flats and noted the program was funded by PennDOT. He discussed surveillance on McCandless roadways, Grubbs Road. He provided clarification to Councilwoman Zachary regarding placement traffic control devices, studies performed and the issuance of citations according to State law.
