MINUTES – PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
March 7, 2016 TOWN HALL

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Committee Chairman LeDonne with the following in attendance: Committee members Zachary, Aufman, Mertz, Powers, Walkauskas and McKim; Town Attorney Ries, Town Manager Cordek, Assistant Town Manager Ebner, Chief Anderson, Mark Sabina, Fire Marshal Stack and Marie Haller; Citizens as per the sign-in sheet.

CHIEFS REPORT

Chief Anderson provided an overview of his February Activity Report and reported there was a burglary at a business with an arrest made. He reported that mandatory in-service training for all officers continues this month. The Committee discussed reported speeding issues. The Chief commented that officers are monitoring roadways and are scheduled to do so again this month. He also mentioned a survey on Grubbs Road indicates the average speed of drivers is 36.7 mph., with 4% traveling 47-50 mph. Tickets may be issued when speed exceeds 10 mph over the posted speed limit.

Brian Moreth, 919 Cumberland, asked for a status update pertaining issuance of citations on Cumberland Road. The Chief stated that there were twenty-on citations issued in February.
