

TOWN OF McCANDLESS
MINUTES – COUNCIL’S PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
OCTOBER 3, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 9:24 p.m. by Committee Chairman Aufman, with the following in attendance: Council Members Zachary, Mertz, Powers, Walkauskas, LeDonne and McKim. Others present: Town Attorney Ries, Town Manager Cordek, Public Works Superintendent Sabina, Zoning Office/Land Use Administrator Betty, Marie Haller, Administrative Assistant and citizens as per the sign-in sheet.

2016 PAVING PROGRAM

Public Works Superintendent Sabina reported crews have backfilled dirt to the curbs and planted grass seed, which he anticipates new growth will occur quickly due to recent rainstorms. He also reported the final invoice from Youngblood Paving will be higher than originally expected because of an increase in base repair. For example, much of Hedwig from Babcock required base repair due to the clay under the base layer.

GRANT REQUEST - GREEN LIGHT GO PROGRAM

A grant application has been submitted to provide funding for updated markings at signalized intersections which would cover 80% of costs: the Town would pay the remaining 20%. Grants are expected to be awarded by the end of this year. Council applauded the strategy and concurred that the remaining 2016 Traffic Control program funding can be rolled over into the 2017 budget, if necessary.
