MINUTES – PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING
MARCH 7, 2016 TOWN HALL

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 8:32 p.m. by Committee Chairman Aufman with the following in attendance: Committee members Zachary, Mertz, Walkauskas, Powers, LeDonne and McKim; Town Attorney Ries, Town Manager Cordek, Assistant Town Manager Ebner, Police Chief Anderson, Public Works Superintendent Sabina, and Marie Haller, Administrative Assistant.

2016 DRAINAGE PROGRAM

Public Works Superintendent Sabina reported drainage work was minimal in February due to weather conditions. There was three-hundred and fifteen feet of pipe installed, two streets were completed and more work will continue, as weather permits.

2015-16 SNOW AND ICE REPORT

Public Works Superintendent Sabina reported the weather in February was mild although there were several days below freezing, requiring crews to go out seventeen times. He reported sixty-seven tons of salt have been used, providing a cost savings for the Town in comparison to previous winters. Mr. Sabina discussed the need to purchase salt from the State replenish supplies to prevent a fee being imposed for salt storage, as requirement per the current contract.

BID TABULATIONS – 2016 PAVING PROGRAM

The Committee reviewed a request for the purchase of a utility and aerial lift from Versalift East, LLC, under COSTARS Contract #25-132, in the amount of \$73,984.00. Mr. Sabina reported a non-COSTARS bid would increase the cost by \$25-30,000. He reported the truck chassis has been received by the dealership and he estimates it will take three or four months for the truck body to be completed. Upon approval, a delivery date will be scheduled.

NOTIFICATION
EXCAVATOR RENTAL WITH OPERATOR

The Committee was notified bids are being sought for the rental of a one cubic yard or larger excavating machine with operator. Mr. Sabina discussed the Council's rejection of the previous bids submitted in February and reported the bid specifications have since been revised, reposted and advertised in accordance with regulations set forth in the Town's Home Rule Charter.

CITIZENS COMMENTS

Mark Donatelli, 9753 Griffith Road, complimented the Public Works crew for doing a great job this year with the removal of snow and ice.
