

TOWN OF McCANDLESS
MINUTES – COUNCIL’S RECREATION COMMITTEE
OCTOBER 3, 2016 TOWN HALL

The meeting was called to order at 9:34 p.m. by Committee Chairwoman Zachary, with the following in attendance: Council Members Aufman, Mertz, Powers, Walkauskas, LeDonne and McKim. Others present: Town Attorney Ries, Town Manager Cordek, Mark Sabina, Public Works Superintendent, Marie Haller, Administrative Assistant and citizens as per the sign-in sheet.

POTENTIAL MODIFICATIONS TO DEVLIN FIELD

Town Manager Cordek provided an overview of potential modifications to Devlin Field that would permit baseball play along with softball play. During this past spring the North Allegheny Little League (NALL) contacted the Town to express interest in Devlin Field and proposed converting the field for to a combination baseball/softball field. For baseball, the backstop will need to be converted and Mark Sabina, Public Works Superintendent, has contacted Maintenance Fence Service, Inc. to provide pricing.

Town Manager Cordek reported he met with Tim Aguglia and Brian Stover from NALL, Ron Carmassi, President of the McCandless Athletic Association, Gary Fritch, President of the Ingomar—Franklin Park Athletic Association and Mark Sabina to discuss potential upgrades. Overviews of the proposed upgrades were reviewed. NALL plans to contribute \$20,000 toward dugouts and the temporary fencing costs; the Town’s estimated cost will be \$34,000. Council concurred that this is a good plan.
