MINUTES – COUNCIL’S PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING
AUGUST 1, 2016 TOWN HALL

The meeting was called to order at 7:34 p.m. by Public Works Committee Chairman Aufman with the following in attendance: Council Members Zachary, Mertz, Powers, Walkauskas, LeDonne and McKim. Others present: Town Manager Cordek, Town Attorney Ries, Bruce Betty, Land Use Manager, Mark Sabina, Public Works Superintendent, Dan Stack, Fire Marshal and Marie Haller, Administrative Assistant.

2016 DRAINAGE PROGRAM

Public Works Superintendent Sabina provided a status update regarding the drainage program. He reported crews are currently completing odds and ends of drainage work throughout the Town and then will begin work to repair or rebuild approximately 20 inlets in the Tallybrooke subdivision. He suggested to property owners that they may want to contact West View water to request a water sample be taken as he suspects there may be an unidentified leak associated with some of the water issues observed.

2016 PAVING PROGRAM

Mr. Sabina reported the paving crew has not worked in McCandless this month, but he expects they will return this week to pave Woodland following West View Water Authority’s completion of work on this street. Work on Fassinger was held off due to a scheduled swim meet per the request of the swim club. Town Manager Cordek noted, the goal is to finish all paving in August to provide the Public Works crew with an opportunity to successfully plant grass in September.
