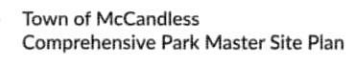

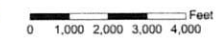




Active Transportation & Connectivity Map

Below are some recent statistics for our Town media and communications methods:

Town Facebook page: Currently sitting at 6,178 follows. Over the last month, posts on the page reached 53,703 people with 231,032 total views, 1,780 content interactions (i.e., likes, shares and comments) and we received 97 new page follows.

Police Facebook page: Currently sitting at 6,851 follows. Over the last month, posts on the page reached 65,507 people with 224,788 total views, 1,724 content interactions and we received 77 new followers.

As the first quarter of the 2025-2026 school year draws to a close, North Allegheny students continue to define success both inside and outside the classroom.

HOSA, the Health Occupations Students of America, is hosting a local physician who will speak on his experience from the medical field. Additionally, the club prepares its members for state and national competitions where they will put their knowledge of health and medicine to the test.

Perspective on Town Issues from Junior Councilman Puri

As mentioned above by Junior Councilman Sperandeo, I want to also give a big thank you to our wonderful emergency services, and all involved behind the scenes as well. Also mentioned above by Councilman Sperandeo, there are so many students that want to pursue a field in medicine that are fascinated with the Town's EMT services, and would like to have more information about how they can learn more.

Junior Councilman Puri would also like to reiterate that the Northland Public Library will serve as a wonderful study ground, and allow students to relax or do work in a safe, appealing environment. Thank you to all involved in that process as well.

Additionally, Councilman Puri would like to note that he is in touch with the National Honors Society at NASH regarding registration for volunteer spots for the Town's Winterfest Event after emailing with Abby Lucostic. It is an exciting time and event!

Report on Initiatives by Junior Councilman Puri

Junior Councilman Puri has furthered his new voter registration initiative discussed last month, while also assisting Councilman Sperandeo with his NextGen initiative.

The Authority was formed by Resolution No. 8 of 1969 of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of McCandless (now the Town of McCandless, a Home Rule municipality) dated October 27, 1969 and filed with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of State on November 17, 1969.
